

2019-nCoV Alert

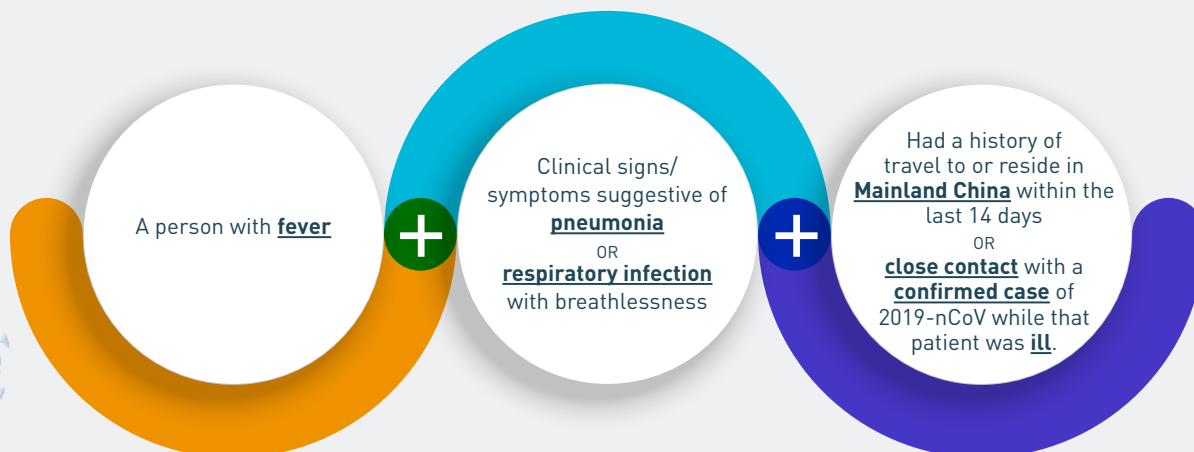

As a hospital, we practice stringent precautionary measures to ensure the highest standards of safety and quality of care for all our patients, visitors, doctors, and healthcare employees.

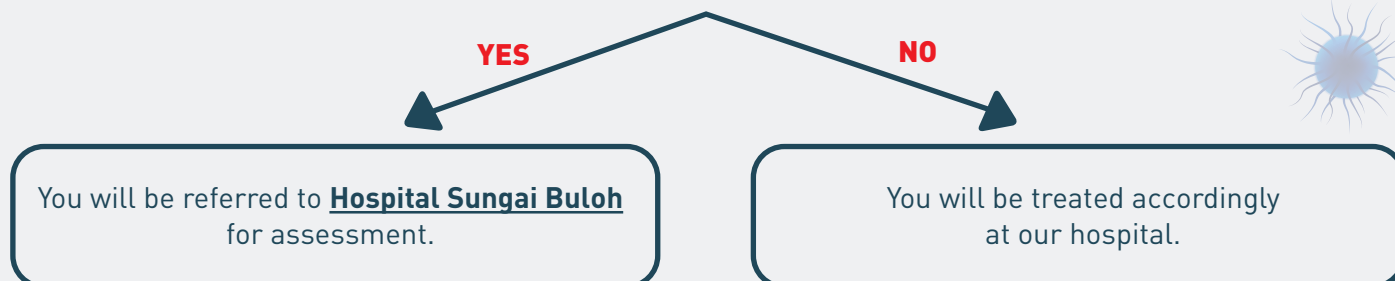
EXTRA PRECAUTIONS TAKEN BY SUNWAY MEDICAL CENTRE

1. **Screening/Triage:** To contain the spread of 2019-nCoV, we limit the number of entrances to screen all visitors entering the hospital, as well as providing a dedicated waiting area for all suspected cases.
2. **Environmental Cleaning:** We conduct thorough cleaning for the entire hospital frequently to ensure a safe environment for all.
3. **Monitoring:** We monitor all our existing patients constantly to ensure prompt recognition and identification of all suspected cases (should there be any).
4. **Awareness:** Our team works relentlessly to debunk many myths and fake news surrounding 2019-nCoV by providing the public with accurate and reliable source of information.
5. **Standard Precautions:** Our dedicated staff from various departments have stepped up and volunteered to assist with the enforcement of standard precautions (ie. hand hygiene, surgical masks).
